What if you could connect all your devices as though they were in the same office, on a single network you provision and control?




How ZeroTier Helps Simplify Your Networking Infrastructure





ZeroTier for IoT Connectivity

The Internet of Things offers extraordinary capacity to help companies achieve all of the benefits above. IoT will unlock \$5.5 trillion to \$12.6 trillion in value globally.¹ From the significant value it brings to manufacturing all the way to the smart device that controls a home thermostat.



But companies need to achieve scale in installation, interoperability, and cybersecurity in order to unlock this potential. Rapid growth of IoT devices allows IoT security vulnerabilities to slip through the cracks, often with devastating consequences: 34% of breaches involving IoT devices lead to losses exceeding \$5 million. An innovative global networking solution like ZeroTier helps companies overcome all of these scaling and security challenges where traditional legacy frameworks fall short.

Ninety-four percent of companies report actively exploring or implementing IoT solutions, and 30% mention struggling with device incompatibility, connectivity, scalability, budget constraints, and security. Implementing IoT utilizing underlying legacy networking doesn't work.² ZeroTier gives you direct two way connection with IoT devices in the field, no matter what networks they are using. The ZeroTier solution is optimized for IoT with device-centric deployments and a lightweight agent that can run on almost any device.



ZeroTier for SD-WAN Deployment

As the modern workplace evolves post-COVID, businesses are increasingly challenged by the inefficiencies of traditional backhauling connectivity from remote locations to central data centers and cloud resources.




Backhauling is not only costly but also inefficient for connecting dispersed sites such as regional offices, retail locations, and campuses. Software-Defined Wide Area Networking (SD-WAN) offers a solution by optimizing network traffic and reducing latency. Businesses that deploy SD-WAN can see an 80% increase in bandwidth efficiency and an 85% improvement in network throughput.³

However, SD-WAN presents its own challenges such as complex configurations, costly scaling due to vendor lock-in, and security vulnerabilities due to its reliance on the public internet. Leveraging solutions like ZeroTier can mitigate these challenges by providing flexible, secure, and direct connections across distributed environments. This connectivity improvement makes SD-WAN deployments efficient and scalable.



ZeroTier for Outdated VPN

Legacy VPN has to backhaul traffic to a centralized location. It also introduces latency and instability, which often causes people to turn off the VPN to connect to the internet. It's also slow and expensive to deploy and maintain.



In June 2023, 72% of organizations expressed that they were slightly to extremely dissatisfied with their VPN service. Only 28% said that they were not dissatisfied at all. The most significant areas of dissatisfaction cited were poor user experience (32%), high costs (14%), difficulty integrating with other systems and services (13%) and complex management and administration (12%).⁴

ZeroTier provides a simple and userfriendly alternative to legacy VPN. ZeroTier's lightweight endpoint agent lets employees access centralized resources securely, without the complication and overhead of a traditional VPN. ZeroTier is easy to deploy, it eliminates the need for routing traffic through a centralized concentrator, and it's a great end-user experience so people no longer need to turn it off.
